6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that absence from the state for
7 medical reasons shall not be considered in computation
8 of longevity bonus; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (b) A recipient directed by a physician to seek medical attention
13 and hospitalization outside the state shall continue to receive bonuses
14 during any continuous absence which does not exceed 90 days, if the
15 recipient notifies the commissioner and furnishes him with a statement,
16 written by his physician, directing the absence from the state as neces-
17 sary for medical reasons.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
19 070(c).
