6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the capital of the State of Alaska,
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.06.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.06.130. SELECTION OF POTENTIAL SITES. The capital
11 selection committee shall, within 12 months of December 11, 1974,
12 select not more than three potential capital sites. [NONE OF THESE
13 SITES MAY BE WITHIN A RADIUS OF 30 MILES OF THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE OR
14 FAIRBANKS.] Each site shall consist of not less than 100 square miles
15 of land that is owned by or may be acquired by the state at no charge
16 to the state. This land shall be contiguous but not necessarily in a
17 rectangular block. Each location shall be immediately classified as
18 "reserved use land" by the division of lands. Each location shall be
19 selected with due regard to its accessibility by road, railroad, 24
20 hour airline service, and terrain necessary for airport construction.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
22 070(c).
