6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public school foundation  
7 program; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.021(c)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) K (minimum level of [AVERAGE] state support of basic  
11 need) = 93 [90] per cent;

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.17.021(c)(5) is amended to read:

13 (5) state aid as computed under this section constitutes at  
14 least 93 [90] per cent of the basic need, as defined by the department,  
15 of each school district.

16 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.17.031(a)(3) is amended to read:

17 (3) the number of units from special education determined  
18 from sec. 41(d) of this chapter as approved by the department; and

1 If a school district is entitled to less than 25 instructional units,  
2 the school district shall receive no less than 107.50 per cent of the  
3 base instructional allotment.

5 Sec. 14.17.051. INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT ALLOTMENT. (a) The instruc-  
6 tional unit allotment for each school district is as follows:

7 (1) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
8 within the boundaries of election district 1, 4 or 8, the district shall  
9 receive the base instructional unit allotment;

10 (2) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
11 within the boundaries of election district 2, 3 or 7, the district shall  
12 receive 103.75 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment;

13 (3) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
14 within the boundaries of election district 5, 9, 10 or 11, the district  
15 shall receive 107.50 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment;

16 (4) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
17 within the boundaries of election district 16, south of the Arctic  
18 Circle, the district shall receive 111.25 per cent of the base instruc-  
19 tional unit allotment;

20 (5) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
21 within the boundaries of election district 6, the district shall receive  
22 115 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment;

23 (6) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
24 within the boundaries of election district 12, 13 or 18, the district  
25 shall receive 126.25 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment;

26 (7) if the school district is in that part of the state lying  
27 within the boundaries of election district 14 or 19, the district shall  
28 receive 130 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment;

29 (8) if the school district is in that part of the state lying

1 within the boundaries of election district 15, 16 (north of the Arctic  
2 Circle) or 17, the district shall receive 133.75 per cent of the base  
3 instructional unit allotment.

4 (b) For the purposes of this section, a school district is con-  
5 sidered to be located in the election district in which its administra-  
6 tive offices are located. However, if a school district operating a  
7 school in a remote area is authorized by the commissioner to calculate  
8 the number of units to which that school is entitled under the provisions  
9 of sec. 31(c) of this chapter, the commissioner may consider that school  
10 to lie in the election district in which it is actually located.

11 (c) For the purposes of this section "election district" means an  
12 election district designated in the governor's proclamation of reappor-  
13 tionment and redistricting of December 7, 1961 and retained as to the  
14 house of representatives by the governor's proclamation of September 3,  
15 1965.

17 Sec. 14.17.056. BASE INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT. (a) The base instruc-  
18 tional unit for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending  
19 June 30, 1976 is \$23,500.

20 (b) The base instructional unit for fiscal years beginning on or  
21 after July 1, 1976 is \$25,000.
