6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to criminal assault."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.15.190 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.15.190. ASSAULT WHILE ARMED. A person who unlawfully  
10 assaults or threatens another in a menacing manner, or unlawfully  
11 strikes or wounds another, [ASSAULTS OR ASSAULTS AND BEATS ANOTHER  
12 WITH A COWHIDE, WHIP, STICK OR LIKE THING,] having at the time in his  
13 possession a dangerous [PISTOL, DIRK, OR OTHER DEADLY] weapon, with  
14 intent to intimidate and prevent the other person from resisting or  
15 defending himself, is punishable by imprisonment [IN THE PENITENTIARY]  
16 for not more than 10 years nor [NOT] less than one year.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 11.15.220 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 11.15.220. ASSAULT WITH DANGEROUS WEAPON. A person armed  
19 with a dangerous weapon, who assaults another with the weapon, is  
20 punishable by imprisonment [IN THE PENITENTIARY] for not more than 10  
21 years nor less than six months, [OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN JAIL FOR NOT  
22 MORE THAN ONE YEAR NOR LESS THAN ONE MONTH,] or by a fine of not more  
23 than \$1,000 nor less than \$100, or by both.

24 \* Sec. 3. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

25 Sec. 11.15.225. AGGRAVATED ASSAULT. (a) A person who unlawfully  
26 assaults another, or who unlawfully strikes or wounds another, under  
27 circumstances or conditions likely to produce great bodily injury, is  
28 guilty of aggravated assault. Upon conviction, a person guilty of  
29 aggravated assault is punishable by imprisonment for not less than

1 six months nor more than five years, or by a fine of not less than  
2 \$100 or more than \$1,000, or by both.

3 (b) Under this section, "great bodily injury" means bodily  
4 injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which causes  
5 serious, permanent disfigurement, or protracted loss or impairment of  
6 the function of any body member or organ.

7 \* Sec. 4. AS 11.15.230 is amended to read:

8 Sec. 11.15.230. ASSAULT AND ASSAULT AND BATTERY. A person [NOT  
9 ARMED WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON,] who unlawfully assaults or threatens  
10 another in a menacing manner, or unlawfully strikes or wounds another,  
11 is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment [IN  
12 A JAIL] for not more than one year [SIX MONTHS], or by both.
