6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to obstruction of an officer."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.30.210 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.30.210. OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER. A person who wilfully
10 obstructs a peace officer in making, or attempting to make, a lawful
11 arrest, or who otherwise wilfully interferes with a peace officer in the
12 performance of his official duties in a way that results in loss or
13 destruction of evidence of a crime or in a way that impedes the preven-
14 tion of a crime or delays an arrest, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and is
15 punishable by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not
16 more than 30 days, or by both.
