6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driving while license cancelled,
7 suspended, or revoked; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.300(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) A person who drives a motor vehicle on a public highway in
12 this state at a time when his privilege to do so has been cancelled,
13 suspended or revoked [BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION] is guilty
14 of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, the court shall impose a
15 minimum sentence of not less than 10 days. The execution of sentence
16 may not be suspended nor may probation or parole be granted until the
17 minimum imprisonment provided in this section has been served, nor may
18 imposition of sentence be suspended, except upon the condition that
19 the defendant be imprisoned for no less than the minimum period
20 provided for in this section, nor may the punishment provided for in
21 this section be reduced under AS 11.05.150.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
23 10.070(c).
