6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to military residency requirements
7 for fish and game licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.940(14) is amended to read:

10 (14) "resident" means a person who for 12 consecutive months
11 has maintained a permanent place of abode in the state and who has
12 continually maintained his voting residence in the state; and in the
13 case of a partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, or
14 corporation, "resident" means one that has its main office or head-
15 quarters in the state; however, a member of the military service on
16 active duty who is [HAS BEEN] stationed in the state [FOR THE PRECEDING
17 12 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS] is a resident for the purposes of this chapter,
18 and the dependent of a resident member of the military service [, WHO
19 HAS BEEN LIVING IN THE STATE FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR] is a resident for
20 the purposes of this chapter, and a person who is an alien but who for
21 one year has maintained a permanent place of abode in the state is a
22 resident for the purposes of this chapter;
