6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fees for hunting and fishing
7 licenses for military personnel; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(7), (8) and (9) are amended to read:

11 (7) Nonresident sport fishing license\$20

12 However, the fee for military personnel is \$5.

13 (8) Nonresident hunting license\$20

14 However, the fee for military personnel is \$7.

15 (9) Nonresident hunting and sport fishing license\$40

16 However, the fee for military personnel is \$12. A nonresident

17 may not take a big game animal without previously purchasing a

18 numbered, nontransferable, appropriate tag, issued to him as

19 provided in (16) of this subsection. The tag shall be affixed

20 to the animal immediately upon taking and shall remain affixed

21 until the animal is prepared for storage, consumed, or exported.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.940 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

23 (26) "military personnel" means a member of the military
24 service on active duty whose permanent change of station is Alaska,
25 and the dependent of any such member of the military service who main-
26 tains a place of abode in the state.

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1976.
