6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to local governments;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.18.010(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (7) \$5 per capita to cities and boroughs providing for
11 garbage and solid waste collection and disposal.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 43.18.030(b) is amended to read:

13 (b) The governing body shall furnish the following notice with
14 tax statements mailed for the fiscal year for which aid is received
15 under this chapter.

16 "NOTICE TO TAXPAYER

17 For the current fiscal year the (city) (borough) has been allocated
18 the following amount of state aid for school and municipal purposes
19 under the Public School Foundation Program (Alaska Statutes 14.17) and
20 the revenue-sharing provisions of Alaska Statutes 43.18:

22	AID BASED ON MUNICIPAL SERVICES FURNISHED	\$
