6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting municipal elections from state law
7 governing election campaign contributions and expen-
8 ditures."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.13.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 15.13.010. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies in every
12 election for governor, lieutenant governor or [,] a member of the state
13 legislature [, OR FOR A MUNICIPAL OFFICE]. A municipality may subject
14 [EXEMPT] itself to [FROM] the requirements of this chapter by an ordin-
15 ance ratified by [IF] a majority of the voters at a general election
16 [VOTE TO EXEMPT THE MUNICIPALITY FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS CHAPTER].
17 Nothing in this chapter prohibits a municipality from regulating by
18 ordinance campaign contributions and expenditures.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 15.13.130(1) is amended to read:

20 (1) "candidate" means a person who files for election to the
21 state legislature, for governor, for lieutenant governor, or for municipi-
22 pal office if the municipality has subjected its candidates to the pro-
23 visions of this chapter;

24 * Sec. 3. AS 15.13.130 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

25 (5) "municipality" means a home rule or general law borough
26 or city including but not limited to a unified municipality organized
27 under AS 29.68.
