6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the creation of judicial districts."
7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 22.10.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 22.10.010. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUPERIOR COURT. There shall be
10 one superior court for the state. The court consists of four judicial
11 districts described as follows:

12 (1) The First Judicial District consists of the territory
13 encompassed within election districts one - six, inclusive, as those
14 districts are described in art. XIV of the Constitution of the State
15 of Alaska, as of March 19, 1959.

16 (2) The Second Judicial District consists of the territory
17 encompassed within election district 21 and that portion of election
18 district 22 located south of 68° North latitude, as those districts are
19 described in art. XIV of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, as of
20 March 19, 1959.

21 (3) The Third Judicial District consists of the territory
22 encompassed within election districts 7 - 17, inclusive, and election
23 district 24, as those districts are described in art. XIV of the
24 Constitution of the State of Alaska, as of March 19, 1959.

25 (4) The Fourth Judicial District consists of the territory
26 encompassed within election districts 18 - 21, inclusive, and that
27 portion of election district 22 located north of 68° North latitude,
28 as those districts are described in art. XIV of the Constitution of
29 the State of Alaska, as of March 19, 1959.
