6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to auditing of municipalities; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.48.220 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 29.48.220. POST AUDIT. The assembly or council shall provide
11 for an annual independent audit of the accounts and financial trans-
12 actions of the municipality or in the case of a second class city may
13 be required to provide an audit or statement of annual income and
14 expenditures. To make the audit the assembly or council shall desig-
15 nate either an independent accountant, a public accountant or a certi-
16 fied public accountant who has no personal interest, direct or indirect,
17 in the fiscal affairs of the municipality. Copies of the audit shall
18 be available to the public upon request. This section applies to home
19 rule and general law municipalities.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
21 070(c).

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
