5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to comprehensive employment and
7 training; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 8. PARTICIPATION IN COMPREHENSIVE EMPLOYMENT

11 AND TRAINING ACT OF 1973.

12 Sec. 44.19.581. GOVERNOR AS PRIME SPONSOR. (a) The governor is
13 authorized to participate as a prime sponsor in the Comprehensive
14 Employment and Training Act of 1973 (P.L. 93-203) as amended. He may
15 delegate his functions as a prime sponsor to such other state agency
16 as, in the exercise of his discretion, he sees fit.

17 (b) The governor, or the state agency to which he has delegated
18 his functions, may adopt regulations necessary to carry out the
19 functions as a prime sponsor.

20 (c) The governor shall submit as part of the annual budget sub-
21 mission to the legislature a complete program budget for state partici-
22 pation in the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973
23 (P.L. 93-203) as amended.

24 Sec. 44.19.591. ALASKA MANPOWER SERVICES COUNCIL. (a) There is
25 created the Alaska Manpower Services Council to review and monitor all
26 manpower activities within the state and advise and make recommendations
27 concerning manpower activities to the governor, prime sponsors under
28 the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, state manpower
29 agencies, and the public.

1 (b) The membership of the council is as provided in the Compre-
2 hensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 as amended (P.L. 93-203;
3 29. U.S.C. 801 et seq.) and the regulations of the U.S. Department of
4 Labor adopted to carry out the Act (29 C.F.R. 19.13).

5 (c) All members of the council shall be appointed by the governor
6 for one-year terms.

7 (d) A member is entitled to the same per diem and expenses as
8 members of other boards and commissions.

9 (e) The powers and duties of the council are as provided in the
10 Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 801 et
11 seq.) and the regulations of the U.S. Department of Labor adopted to
12 carry out the Act (29 C.F.R. 19.13(d)) and are to

13 (1) cooperate with federal and independent agencies;

14 (2) present an annual report of its activities to the
15 legislature at the start of each legislative session;

16 (3) emphasize through publicity and persuasion the importance
17 and desirability of hiring residents of the state to the fullest extent
18 possible.

20 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
21 070(c).
