6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to revenue sharing for road
7 maintenance."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.18.010(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) During each fiscal year the state shall pay to a city or
11 organized borough of any class which has power to provide for road
12 maintenance and exercises the power a sum equal to \$1,500 a mile for
13 each mile of road, street or highway maintained by the local government,
14 excluding the official state highway system, roads, streets or highways
15 not dedicated to public use, any roads, streets or highways maintained
16 under the local service road program (AS 19.30.111 - 19.30.251), and
17 alleyways, in accordance with regulations adopted by the Department of
18 Highways. No payments may be made for maintenance of roads not used
19 by automotive equipment. Frozen waterways and connections from inhabited
20 areas to the waterways which may be safely used for public transportation
21 by automotive equipment and are so used during a portion of a year are
22 eligible for payments of \$900 per mile if the waterways and connections
23 are maintained during the period of use by a municipality or combination
24 of municipalities. The Department of Community and Regional Affairs,
25 after consultation with the Department of Highways, shall determine
26 which waterways and connections qualify and, where the waterways or
27 connections lie outside the corporate limits of a municipality, which
28 municipality is eligible for the shared revenue unless the municipalities
29 involved have agreed in writing to a particular distribution.

1 * Sec. 2. AS 29.48.037(a) is amended to read:

2 (a) A municipality may provide parks, roads (including ice roads),
3 trails, playgrounds, cemeteries and airports outside its boundaries,
4 subject to AS 29.33.010, and may regulate their use and operation. A
5 regulation adopted under this section must state that it applies
6 outside the municipality.
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
