6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to outdoor advertising control; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19.25.105(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (3) signs determined by the state, subject to concurrence of
11 the United States Department of Transportation, to be landmark signs,
12 including signs on farm structures, or natural surfaces, of historic or
13 artistic significance, the preservation of which would be consistent
14 with the provisions of this chapter.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 19.25.105 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (c) No outdoor advertising may be erected or maintained beyond
17 660 feet of the nearest edge of the right-of-way of the main traveled
18 way of the interstate, primary or secondary highways in this state with
19 the purpose of their message being read from that travel way except those
20 outdoor advertising signs, displays or devices allowed under (a) of this
21 section.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 19.25.110 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 19.25.110. REMOVAL OF NONCONFORMING ADVERTISING. A sign,
24 display or device which is lawfully in existence along the interstate
25 system or the primary system on August 6, 1968 and which is not in
26 conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this chapter may not be required to be
27 removed until July 1, 1970. A sign, display or device which is lawfully
28 in existence along the secondary system on July 1, 1970 and which is not
29 in conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this chapter shall be removed by

1 July 1, 1971. A sign, display or device which on the effective date of
2 this Act, is lawfully in existence beyond 660 feet of the nearest edge of
3 the right-of-way of the interstate, primary, or secondary highways and
4 which is not in conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this chapter shall be
5 removed by July 1, 1976.

6 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
7 070(c).
