6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to outdoor advertising control; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 19.25.105(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (3) signs determined by the state, subject to concurrence of the  
11 United States Department of Transportation, to be landmark signs,  
12 including signs on farm structures, or natural surfaces, of historic  
13 or artistic significance, the preservation of which would be consistent  
14 with the provisions of this chapter.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 19.25.105 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (c) No outdoor advertising may be erected or maintained beyond  
17 660 feet of the nearest edge of the right-of-way of the main traveled  
18 way of the interstate or primary highways in this state with the  
19 purpose of their message being read from that travel way except  
20 those outdoor advertising signs, displays or devices allowed under (a)  
21 of this section.

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 19.25.110 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 19.25.110. REMOVAL OF NONCONFORMING ADVERTISING. A sign,  
24 display or device which is lawfully in existence along the interstate  
25 system or the primary system on August 6, 1968 and which is not in  
26 conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this chapter may not be required to  
27 be removed until July 1, 1970. A sign, display or device which is  
28 lawfully in existence along the secondary system on July 1, 1970 and  
29 which is not in conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this chapter shall

1 be removed by July 1, 1971. A sign, display or device which on the  
2 effective date of this Act, is lawfully in existence beyond 660 feet  
3 of the nearest edge of the right-of-way of the interstate or primary  
4 highways and which is not in conformity with secs. 80 - 180 of this  
5 chapter shall be removed by July 1, 1976.
