6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the dedication of land for public
7 highways; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19.10.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 19.10.010. DEDICATION OF LAND FOR PUBLIC HIGHWAYS. A tract
11 100 feet wide between each section of land owned by the state, or
12 acquired from the state, and a tract 4 rods wide between all other
13 sections in the state, is dedicated for use as public highways, except
14 that existing dedications on state land designated by the legislature as
15 a state park or recreation area or a state historic site or monument
16 under the jurisdiction of the Department of Natural Resources or a state
17 game refuge or sanctuary or a fish and game critical habitat area under
18 the jurisdiction of the Department of Fish and Game are void and no such
19 dedications may be made after the effective date of this Act. The sec-
20 tion line is the center of the dedicated right-of-way. If the highway
21 is vacated, title to the strip inures to the owner of the tract of which
22 it formed a part by the original survey.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
