6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Capital Site Selection Com-
7 mittee; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.06.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.06.130. SELECTION OF POTENTIAL SITES. The capital selec-
11 tion committee shall, within 12 months of December 11, 1974, select not
12 more than three potential capital sites. None of these sites may be
13 within a radius of 30 miles of the City of Anchorage or Fairbanks. Each
14 site shall consist of not less than 100 square miles of land that is
15 owned by or may be acquired by the state at no charge to the state.
16 This land shall be contiguous but not necessarily in a rectangular
17 block. Each location shall be immediately classified as "reserved use
18 land" by the division of lands. Each location shall be selected with
19 due regard to its accessibility by road, railroad, 24 hour airline
20 service, and terrain necessary for airport construction. In addition,
21 the committee shall take into consideration in selecting each location
22 the projected cost of construction of the basic public and private
23 facilities which will be required and the impact, both economic and
24 social, on the affected areas of the state.

25 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
26 070(c).
