5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Department  
7 of Community and Regional Affairs; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. The sum of \$2,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
11 to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs to be allocated as oil  
12 development impact discretionary grants by the department to communities ex-  
13 perencing oil development impact along the route of the trans-Alaska pipe-  
14 line.

15 \* Sec. 2. Before approving an oil development impact grant the Department  
16 of Community and Regional Affairs shall

17 (1) require certification, with supporting information, by the  
18 community that the grant is needed because of oil development impact and not  
19 because of normal growth;

20 (2) determine that the community applying for the grant is, where  
21 applicable, presently taxing its citizens at the maximum practicable rate;  
22 and

23 (3) approve the project for which the grant funds are to be  
24 expended.

25 \* Sec. 3. Allocations may be made from this appropriation to state  
26 agencies when circumstances clearly indicate that a state agency can more  
27 efficiently, economically, and expeditiously provide the required service.  
28 Instances where allocations to state agencies are made for the provision of  
29 impact services shall be subject to prior approval of the communities.

1 \* Sec. 4. The unexpended and unobligated balances of the appropriation  
2 made by this Act lapse into the general fund on June 30, 1976.

3 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1975.
