6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limited entry permits; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.43.100(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (14) establish the minimum number of weeks per season that a  
11 fisherman must actively fish in order for his permit to be renewable.

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 16.43.150(c) is amended to read:

13 (c) Each entry permit is issued for a term of one year and is  
14 renewable annually, provided that for at least two of three years he  
15 has held an entry permit the entry permit holder shall have fished the  
16 minimum number of weeks per season as prescribed by the commission.

17 \* Sec. 3. AS 16.43.170 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

18 (e) An inactive permit as specified in sec. 150(c) of this chapter  
19 may not be transferred as provided in this section.

20 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
21 070(c).
