6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for disclosure of the names of
7 contractors and the terms of certain public contracts;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 36 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 30. DISCLOSURE OF CONTENTS OF PUBLIC CONTRACTS.

12 Sec. 36.30.010. PURPOSE OF CHAPTER. The purpose of this chapter
13 is to provide for annual reporting of the names of private contractors
14 and the terms of the contractual agreements in all public contracts
15 involving payment of \$1,000 or more in state funds to a contractor
16 in a fiscal year.

17 Sec. 36.30.020. ANNUAL REPORT. The commissioner of administra-
18 tion shall publish an annual report before September 15 containing

19 (1) the names of contractors receiving or contracting to
20 receive in the future \$1,000 or more in state funds during the previous
21 fiscal year, and the owners or major stockholders of the contractors;

22 (2) the principal place of business of the contractors
23 reported;

24 (3) the contracting state agency;

25 (4) the terms of the contracts between the state and the
26 contractors reported under (1) of this section paid or entered into
27 during the previous fiscal year, including but not limited to the con-
28 tract period, the consideration, and the product, service or work to be
29 performed.

1 Sec. 36.30.030. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter

2 (1) "contractor" includes subcontractor and lessor;

3 (2) "major stockholder" means a person holding 10 per cent or
4 more of the ownership interest of a corporation at any time during the
5 fiscal year of the report.

6 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
7 070(c).
