For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to membership of the advisory board  
7 on alcoholism."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 47.37.080 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 47.37.080. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. Of the nine

members

(1) two shall be persons who are licensed to practice medi-  
cine in the state, one of whom shall be certified in psychiatry by the  
14 American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or eligible for that certi-  
15 fication, except that if a psychiatrist is not available a clinical  
16 psychologist may be appointed;

(2) one shall be a practicing attorney who has been admitted  
to the practice of law by the state supreme court;

(3) two shall be persons who have evidenced an interest in  
the problems of alcoholism and who have knowledge of the social problems  
21 encountered in the rehabilitation of alcoholics;

(4) one shall be a public health nurse;

(5) one shall be a representative of the liquor industry;

(6) one shall be from the public at large;

(7) one shall be a social worker.
