6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the legislature."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 24.05.080 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 24.05.080. TERMS. The term of each member of the legislature
10 begins on the second [THIRD] Monday in January following a presidential
11 election year; however, following a gubernatorial election year, the
12 term of each member begins on the third Monday in January. The term of
13 representatives is two years, and the term of senators is four years.
14 One-half of the senators shall be elected every two years.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene
17 at the capital each year on the second [THIRD] Monday in January at
18 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time; however, following a gubernatorial
19 election year the legislature shall convene on the third Monday in
20 January at 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time. Except as provided in this
21 section, each [EACH] legislature shall have a duration of two years
22 and shall consist of a "First Regular Session" which shall meet in the
23 odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session" which shall meet in
24 the even-numbered years and any special session or sessions which the
25 governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
