5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to industrial safety."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. The legislature finds that proper training is an essential
9 part of industrial safety and that the responsibility for providing job
10 training is one that can best be borne by a joint effort between government
11 and industry.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 18.60.030 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

13 (12) require an employer to submit a job-training program
14 for approval if the commissioner determines that a job-training program
15 would be likely to reduce the personal injuries in that particular
16 work situation.

17 * Sec. 3. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

18 Sec. 18.60.043. ADMINISTRATION OF JOB-TRAINING PROGRAM. When the
19 commissioner has determined under sec. 30(12) of this chapter that a job-
20 training program is required, the program, as approved by the depart-
21 ment, shall be administered by the University of Alaska.

22 Sec. 18.60.046. COSTS OF JOB TRAINING. All costs of job-training
23 programs under sec. 43 of this chapter shall be the responsibility of
24 the employer. The employer shall be billed by the commissioner of
25 administration for all costs certified to him by the department and the
26 University of Alaska.
