6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to licensing of cosmetologists and
7 hairdressers."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.28.040 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

10 (5) except as provided in sec. 280 of this chapter, may
11 inspect schools and shops in order to enforce the provisions of this
12 chapter;

13 (6) may, on its own motion, and shall, upon receipt of a
14 written complaint, investigate the practices of a person, shop, or
15 school licensed under this chapter.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 08.28 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 08.28.055. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY. (a) Subject to the approval
18 of the board, the department shall appoint a licensed hairdresser, who
19 is not a member of the board, to serve as executive secretary for the
20 board. The board may dismiss the executive secretary for cause.

21 (b) The executive secretary shall hold a current hairdresser's
22 license in the state, with at least five years active hairdressing
23 experience and two years secretarial experience.

24 (c) The executive secretary shall

25 (1) perform the administrative duties assigned by the board
26 or the department;

27 (2) provide the administrative support services for the
28 board that are not provided by the department under AS 08.01.050,
29 including preparation of board minutes; and

1 (3) assist the board in conducting examinations, inspections
2 and investigations.

4 Sec. 08.28.100. LICENSE REQUIRED. No person may engage in the
5 practice of hairdressing or beauty culture or organize, open, or
6 conduct a school or shop of hairdressing and beauty culture without a
7 license.

9 Sec. 08.28.105. EMPLOYMENT IN LICENSED SCHOOL OR SHOP. No person
10 may employ a person to engage in the practice of hairdressing or beauty
11 culture except in a licensed shop or school and except a person em-
12 ployed to engage in hairdressing or beauty culture for hospitalized or
13 handicapped persons.

15 (4) have training of at least 2,000 hours, extending over a
16 school term of not less than 50 weeks in a school of hairdressing or
17 beauty culture approved by the board, or service as an apprentice under
18 a licensed operator in a shop approved by the board or completed training
19 and working experience as a hairdresser in another state or country
20 which the board finds to meet the minimum requirements of this state.

22 Sec. 08.28.140. OUT-OF-STATE LICENSES. A person holding a current
23 valid license from a board of cosmetology and hairdressing in another
24 state or country is entitled to a license under this chapter without
25 examination if he applies, accompanying his application with

26 (1) proof of a foreign license;

27 (2) proof that he has completed at least 2,000 hours of [,]
28 training in a hairdressing and beauty culture school or service as an
29 apprentice under a licensed hairdresser in a shop approved by the board

1 or completed training and working experience as a hairdresser which the
2 board finds to meet the minimum requirements of the state;

3 (3) payment of an investigation fee.

5 Sec. 08.28.145. OUT-OF-STATE DEMONSTRATORS. The board may issue
6 a temporary demonstrator's permit to out-of-state hairdressers or
7 cosmetologists without examination. The expiration date of the permit
8 will be determined by the board. The applicant shall submit to the
9 board

10 (1) a completed application and \$10 out-of-state demon-
11 strator's permit fee; and

12 (2) proof of a current valid cosmetology or hairdresser's
13 license from another state or country.

24 dressing or beauty culture school representing itself to be approved or
25 accredited shall indicate the organization or agency issuing the approval
26 or accreditation.
