6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Ferry Transportation Act; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.25.180 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.25.180. STATE-OPERATED FERRIES. Nothing in this chapter
11 prevents the state from operating ferries or ferry systems inside or
12 outside the state. However, unless actually subjected to regulation
13 by the United States Interstate Commerce Commission, the state ferries
14 or state ferry systems are subject to regulation under this chapter,
15 including but not limited to the award of certificates of public
16 convenience and necessity and to the tariffs or charges for those
17 state ferry services.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 42.25.210(2) is amended to read:

19 (2) "ferry" means a vessel used in the common carriage of
20 passengers or [AND] self-propelled vehicles in intrastate commerce,
21 or in interstate commerce if the ferry is not actually subjected to
22 regulation by the United States Interstate Commerce Commission;

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
