6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.10.172. EXPIRATION OF REGISTRATION. Beginning with the
11 calendar year 1977, vehicles required to be registered under this chap-
12 ter shall be registered annually under a system of staggered registration
13 as prescribed in regulations promulgated by the department. Every
14 vehicle registered, every registration card, and every registration
15 plate issued under this chapter expires at midnight on the expiration
16 date set by the department. The owner of a registered vehicle may oper-
17 ate the vehicle under the registration for the preceding year upon
18 displaying the registration plates issued for that year until a period
19 after the appropriate time of registration has passed as prescribed in
20 regulations promulgated by the department.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.180 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 28.10.180. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. The owner shall renew
23 his vehicle registration upon application and payment of the annual
24 license tax for the vehicle. The department may receive applications
25 for registration or renewal registration and issue new registration
26 cards and plates at any time before expiration of registration, but no
27 person may display the new registration plates on a vehicle before the
28 commencement of the appropriate registration date set by the department
29 for the new registration period [JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR FOR WHICH THE

1 PLATES ARE ISSUED].

2 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.240 is repealed.

3 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.170 is repealed.

4 * Sec. 5. Secs. 1 - 3 of this Act take effect immediately in accordance
5 with AS 01.10.070(c); sec. 4 of this Act takes effect January 1, 1977.
