6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring proof of payment of property tax as  
7 condition of registration."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 29.53 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 29.53.190. CERTIFICATE OF PAYMENT. Upon receipt of payment  
11 in full of property taxes on a motor vehicle subject to registration and  
12 licensing under Alaska law, the borough shall issue to the taxpayer a  
13 certificate of payment specifying the description and license number of  
14 each vehicle taxed.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.070 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 28.10.070. LICENSE TAX AND CERTIFICATE OF PAYMENT TO ACCOM-  
17 PANY APPLICATION. At the time of applying for registration the appli-  
18 cant shall pay the license tax provided in this chapter and submit a  
19 certificate of payment of municipal property taxes on the vehicle issued  
20 under AS 29.53.190 if the owner resides in a municipality imposing a  
21 property tax.

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 28.10.100 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

23 (5) that the certificate of payment of municipal property  
24 taxes last due on the vehicle has not been provided.

25 \* Sec. 4. AS 28.10.180 is amended to read:

26 Sec. 28.10.180. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. The owner shall renew  
27 his vehicle registration upon application, [AND] payment of the annual  
28 license tax for the vehicle and submission of a certificate of payment  
29 of the property taxes last due on the motor vehicle if the owner resides

1 in a municipality imposing a property tax on the vehicle. The depart-  
2 ment may receive applications for registration or renewal registration  
3 and issue new registration cards and plates at any time before expiration  
4 of registration, but no person may display the new registration plates  
5 on a vehicle before January 1 of the year for which the plates are  
6 issued.
