6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the visitation privileges of
7 prisoners; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 33.30.150 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 33.30.150. VISITATION PRIVILEGES. An honor prisoner with
11 good behavior serving a sentence of one year or more may be permitted
12 as a privilege and not as a right to visit with his family or any person
13 at a place other than his place of confinement and at his own expense
14 for a period not exceeding one week nor more frequently than once each
15 six months under rules and regulations adopted by the commissioner and
16 in his sole discretion.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
18 070(c).
