6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sick leave credited as service  
7 credit in the Public Employee's Retirement System of  
8 Alaska."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39.35 is amended by adding new sections to read:

11 Sec. 39.35.355. REINSTATED SICK LEAVE. If an employee's employ-  
12 ment is terminated for any reason before he becomes eligible for a  
13 retirement benefit and the employee is subsequently reemployed within  
14 three years by a participating employer, the employee is entitled to  
15 have reinstated in full the sick leave he had accumulated at the time  
16 of his last termination.

17 Sec. 39.35.365. SICK LEAVE COMPUTED AS SERVICE CREDIT. Upon  
18 retirement, a participating employee is entitled to receive service  
19 credit for his accumulated sick leave. For purposes of determining  
20 his service credit for the entire period of employment, the employee's  
21 sick leave shall be computed as service credit at the same rate of pay  
22 as his salary on retirement.
