6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative administration; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.05.190(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) The state capitol, with the exception of the capitol space  
11 now occupied by the Office of the Governor, and space occupied in any  
12 other state building by the legislature or its agencies is under the  
13 control of and subject to assignment by the Legislative Affairs Agency  
14 as directed by the legislature. The Legislative Affairs Agency is  
15 responsible for the equitable allocation of parking spaces at the capitol  
16 according to the needs of the legislature and other agencies occupying  
17 capitol offices.

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 24.20.140 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 24.20.140. APPROPRIATIONS. Appropriations for carrying out  
20 secs. 10 - 140 of this chapter shall be set forth in the general appropri-  
21 ation bill or such other bills as may be necessary. The council may  
22 direct the executive director to transfer amounts from one appropriation  
23 to another if the transfer is considered necessary to accomplish the  
24 work of the council. The council may not exceed the total amount of the  
25 authorized appropriation. All expenditures of the council are subject  
26 to an independent audit which shall be made annually.

27 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
28 070(c).
