5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$4,150,000 for the purpose
8 of paying the cost of capital improvements to health
9 care facilities; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
12 to health care facilities, general obligation bonds of the state in the
13 principal amount of not more than \$4,150,000 shall be issued and sold. The
14 full faith, credit and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of
15 the principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds.
16 These bonds shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those pro-
17 visions read at the time of issuance.

18 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
19 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1976
20 Health Care Facilities Construction Fund" shall be established, to which
21 shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1
22 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums. There is appropri-
23 ated from the "1976 Health Care Facilities Construction Fund" to the Depart-
24 ment of Health and Social Services the amount of \$4,150,000. To the extent
25 feasible, the proceeds of these bonds shall be allocated by the governor in
26 accordance with the following projects and estimates:

<u>Project</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Amount</u>
(1) Health and Family Services Center	Cordova	\$ 300,000

1	(2) Community Hospital	Sitka	3,000,000
2	(3) Health Center	Fairbanks	300,000
3	(4) Health Center	Barrow	350,000
4	(5) Health Center	Nenana	200,000

5 * Sec. 3. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
6 voters of the state, the amount of \$14,400 or as much of that amount as is
7 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
8 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
9 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
10 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
11 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of the
12 bonds authorized by this Act.

13 * Sec. 4. The amount withdrawn from the Public Facility Planning Fund for
14 the purpose of advance planning for the improvements financed under this Act
15 shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds
16 authorized by this Act.

17 * Sec. 5. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to be
18 issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the next
19 general election and shall read substantially as follows:

20 Proposition

21 State General Obligation Health Care Facilities
22 Bonds \$4,150,000

23 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation bonds
24 in the principal amount of not more than \$4,150,000 for the
25 purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements to health
26 care facilities in the state?
