Sec. 23.10.380. RIGHT TO RETURN TRANSPORTATION. (a) An employer who furnishes, finances, agrees to furnish or finance, or in any way provides transportation for a person from the place of hire to a point inside or outside the state to employ him shall provide the person with return transportation to the place of hire from which transportation was furnished or financed, or to a destination agreed upon by the parties, with transportation to be furnished or financed on the first available mode of reasonable transportation. However, if the termination is by the employee before the termination of the contract for hire due to a union strike or work stoppage, the employer is not responsible for providing return transportation under this subsection.

(b) Nothing in this section prohibits a contract of employment from allowing an employer to withhold wages from the employee to cover the costs of the return transportation or prohibits the payment of a wage bonus for completion of the full employment term.
