6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to payment of wages in the state."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 23.10.040 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (e) No employer may deposit wages due or to become due or an
10 advance on wages to be earned in an account in a bank, savings and loan
11 association or credit union unless the employee has voluntarily author-
12 ized the deposit. All deposits under this section shall be in a bank,
13 savings and loan association or credit union of the employee's choice.
14 If an employer discharges an employee or the employee quits, the volun-
15 tary authorization for deposit is considered terminated.

16 (f) No employer may require an employee to accept payment of wages
17 by mail when the effect would be to delay the employee's pay.
