SENATE CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 648 am  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to payment of wages in the state."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.10.040 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(e) No employer may deposit wages due or to become due or an advance on wages to be earned in an account in a bank, savings and loan association or credit union unless the employee has voluntarily authorized the deposit. All deposits under this section shall be in a bank, savings and loan association or credit union of the employee's choice. If an employer discharges an employee or the employee quits, the voluntary authorization for deposit is considered terminated.
