6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the unauthorized connection to  
7 cable television lines."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.20.495 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.20.495. FRAUDULENT USE OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE. A  
11 person is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by  
12 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than  
13 \$1,000, or by both, if he, with intent to defraud or to aid and abet  
14 another to defraud a person of the lawful charge, in whole or in part,  
15 for a telecommunication service, including cable television, obtains or  
16 attempts to obtain, or aids and abets another to obtain or to attempt to  
17 obtain a telecommunication service

18 (1) by charging the service to an existing telephone number  
19 or credit card number without the authority of the subscriber to it or  
20 the legitimate holder of it;

21 (2) by charging the service to a nonexistent, false, ficti-  
22 tious, or counterfeit telephone number or credit card number or to a  
23 suspended, terminated, expired, canceled, or revoked telephone number or  
24 credit card number;

25 (3) by use of a code, prearranged scheme, or other similar  
26 stratagem or device by which the person, in effect, sends or receives  
27 information; [OR]

28 (4) by any other trick, stratagem, impersonation, false  
29 pretense, false representation, false statement, contrivance, device or

1 means; or

2 (5) by the unauthorized connection of wires or cable to cable  
3 television service lines.
