8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.07.091 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 42.07.091. LEGAL COUNSEL. (a) Legal counsel to the commis-
11 sion is provided by a special assistant to the attorney general who
12 shall have his office located in the commission offices and shall be
13 assigned full time to the commission. The special assistant shall be
14 appointed by the attorney general from a list of three candidates
15 submitted by the commission, and after appointment is subject to removal
16 by the attorney general only for cause.

17 (b) The special assistant attorney general may employ additional
18 attorneys, economists or other persons as needed to carry out his duties
19 to the commission.
