6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to assessments on state lands."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 29.63.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 29.63.010. ASSESSMENT AND PROPOSAL. The assembly or council
10 may assess against the property of a governmental unit and private
11 real property benefited all or a portion of the cost of constructing
12 or improving capital improvements. The state shall pay an assessment
13 levied, subject to appropriation by the legislature, except as otherwise
14 provided by law and subject to its right of protest under sec. 15(a)(8)
15 of this chapter. The assessment shall be submitted to the state
16 agency having jurisdiction over the property for purposes of notice
17 and protest and also to the Department of Administration for purposes
18 of requesting an appropriation. No penalty or interest of any kind
19 may be added to the assessment on the property of the state. If a
20 governmental unit other than the state benefited by an assessment
21 refuses to pay the assessment, it shall be denied the benefit of the
22 improvement. An improvement proposal may be initiated by

23 (1) petition to the assembly or council of the owners of
24 one-half in value of the property to be benefited; or

25 (2) the assembly or council.
