6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to requiring certification to the
7 court should the parties to an action for money judgment
8 exchange money in settlement of the case before
9 or after judgment is rendered."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 09.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 09.30.080. CERTIFICATION OF PAYMENT AND SATISFACTION OF
13 JUDGMENTS. (a) The plaintiff to an action for money judgment shall
14 certify to the court within ten days if the parties reach a settlement
15 of the action before judgment is rendered by the court. If the prevail-
16 ing party in an action for money judgment receives full payment from the
17 opposing party of the full amount of a judgment rendered in his favor
18 and that payment is not a matter of public record, or if the parties
19 reach an accord and make satisfaction after the judgment is rendered for
20 less than the full amount of the judgment, the party in whose favor the
21 judgment was rendered shall so certify to the court within ten days.

22 (b) A judgment rendered by any court may be satisfied by payment
23 of less than the full amount of the judgment without the necessity for
24 further exchange of new or collateral consideration.

25 (c) No person engaged in supplying credit information to others
26 for remuneration may publish information available in court records
27 unless that person notes in the published material whether or not
28 certification under (a) of this section has been filed.
