6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration, bonds and insurance
7 required of construction contractors; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.18.161(9) is amended to read:

11 (9) work on one project under [UNDERTAKING BY] one or more
12 contracts, the aggregate contract price of which for labor and materials
13 and all other items is less than \$10,000 [\$1,000], this work being
14 considered as of a casual, minor, on inconsequential nature; this
15 exemption does not apply when the work is only a part of a larger or
16 major operation, whether undertaken by the same or a different con-
17 tractor, or when the work is divided [IN WHICH DIVISION OF THE OPERA-
18 TION IS MADE] into contracts of amounts less than \$10,000 [\$1,000] for
19 the purpose of evasion of this chapter or otherwise; this exemption
20 does not apply to a person who advertises or puts out a sign or card
21 or other device which might indicate to the public that he is a
22 contractor, or that he is qualified to engage in the contracting
23 business; a contractor who performs work priced at \$1,000 or more, under
24 this exemption, shall nevertheless keep in force public liability and
25 property damage insurance with coverage in at least the amounts set out
26 in sec. 101 of this chapter;

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
