5 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to unified local govern-  
6 ments; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 43.18 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 43.18.040. UNIFIED MUNICIPALITIES. If a borough and the  
11 cities within the borough unify in accordance with AS 29.68, the uni-  
12 fied municipality shall receive for the fiscal year in which unification  
13 occurred, and each year thereafter, at least the amount of state shared  
14 revenue for all purposes that the former governments would have received  
15 if unification had not occurred.

16 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
17 070(c).
