BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

(7) may initiate, intervene in, and appear personally or by
11 counsel and offer evidence in and participate in, any proceedings
12 involving a pipeline carrier, and affecting the interests of the state,
13 before any officer, department, board, commission or court of this
14 state [OR OF ANOTHER STATE OR OF THE UNITED STATES];

* Sec. 2. AS 42.06.140 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(10) shall provide all reasonable assistance to the Depart-
17 ment of Law in intervening in, offering evidence in, and participating
18 in proceedings involving a pipeline carrier and affecting the interests
19 of the state, before an officer, department, board, commission or court
20 of another state or the United States.

Sec. 42.06.230. JURISDICTION OF COMMISSION. Except as otherwise
23 provided in this chapter or hereafter otherwise expressly provided by
24 law, [AND] except as to any concurrent jurisdiction with the Alaska
25 Public Utilities Commission under ch. 5 of this title as to a public
26 utility described in AS 42.05.701(2)(D) and (E), and except as to
27 jurisdiction of the Department of Law as provided by sec. 140(10) of
28 this chapter, the jurisdiction and authority over the subject matter of
29 this chapter is exclusively in the commission. To the extent that the

1 performance of any duties of the commission affect a pipeline carrier or
2 a pipeline subject to the Interstate Commerce Act or the Natural Gas
3 Act, the performance of its duties shall not, as to that pipeline
4 carrier or pipeline, conflict with applicable federal laws, regulations,
5 rules, orders, or other requirements.
