6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to trophy tags."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(9) is amended to read:

9 (9) Nonresident hunting and sport fishing license. . . . .40  
10 A nonresident may not take a big game animal without previously purchas-  
11 ing a numbered, nontransferable, appropriate tag, issued to him as pro-  
12 vided in (16) of this subsection. The tag shall be affixed to the  
13 animal immediately upon taking and shall remain affixed until the animal  
14 is prepared for storage, consumed, or exported.

15 (A) When the hide of an animal alone is salvaged the  
16 metal locking tag shall be securely attached and locked to the hide.

17 (B) When the meat of an animal alone is salvaged the  
18 metal locking tag shall be securely attached and locked to the  
19 largest retained portion of meat.

20 (C) In the case of animals that have horns, antlers, or  
21 tusks and the horns, antlers, or tusks are salvaged the metal  
22 locking tag shall be securely attached and locked to the salvaged  
23 skull plate, antler, horn, or tusk.
