6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to instruction centers in public
7 buildings; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 35.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 CHAPTER 27. ART WORKS AND INSTRUCTION CENTERS

11 IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES.

12 Sec. 35.27.025. INSTRUCTION CENTER REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC BUILD-
13 INGS. (a) Plans for public buildings designed to accommodate more than
14 40 employees or which are the main public building in a small community,
15 as determined by the department, constructed after June 30, 1976, and
16 plans for remodeling or renovation of those buildings after June 30,
17 1976, when the total cost of remodeling or renovation is \$250,000 or
18 more, shall contain provisions for the inclusion of not less than one
19 instruction center.

20 (b) An instruction center is not required for a building specified
21 in (a) of this section if the Department of Education, after notifica-
22 tion of the plan, files a written statement with the Department of
23 Public Works that the center is unnecessary or inappropriate.

24 (c) In this section "instruction center" means a room or enclosed
25 area or space created for the purpose of employee educational training
26 purposes.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
