6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hiring of Alaska residents as
7 school teachers."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.220. HIRING OF ALASKA RESIDENTS AS TEACHERS. (a) Each
11 public school district that hires either a teacher who has been awarded
12 a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution of higher learning
13 located in Alaska, or a teacher who has resided in Alaska for one year
14 immediately before the commencement of their initial teaching duties,
15 shall be granted a sum of money in accordance with (b) of this section.

16 (b) Each public school district that hires a teacher which satis-
17 fies the requirements of (a) of this section is entitled to the sum of
18 \$3,000 for the first year of the teacher's employment, the sum of \$2,000
19 for the second year of the teacher's employment and \$1,000 for the third
20 year of the teacher's employment.
