6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to telephone service regulation."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 42.05.241 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (b) No public utility may provide multiple party telephone lines  
10 which serve more than four subscribers unless the commission by order  
11 allows service to more than four. The order must be based upon a find-  
12 ing by the commission that the utility will be able to provide service  
13 that does not serve more than four subscribers with equipment which will  
14 be installed within a reasonable time not to exceed 90 days or a finding  
15 that this requirement in the light of the total circumstances would  
16 make the operation of the utility economically unfeasible.
