6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Executive Budget Act: and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.07.080(c)(3) is repealed.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 37.07.080(e) is amended to read:

11 (e) Transfers [APPROPRIATION TRANSFERS] or changes [AS] between
12 objects of expenditures or between allocations [ACTIVITY AREAS WITHIN A
13 PROGRAM] may be made by the head of a state agency upon approval of the
14 division. [APPROPRIATION TRANSFERS OR CHANGES BETWEEN PROGRAMS WITHIN
15 AN AGENCY MAY BE MADE UPON REVIEW BY THE DIVISION AND APPROVAL OF THE
16 GOVERNOR, AND SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE LEGISLATURE QUARTERLY.] No
17 transfers may be made between appropriations [AGENCIES].

18 * Sec. 3. AS 37.07.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (g) The governor may direct the withholding or reduction of
20 appropriations to a state agency at any time during the fiscal year only
21 if he determines that

22 (1) the planned expenditures can no longer be made due to
23 factors outside the control of the state which make the expenditure
24 factually impossible; or

25 (2) estimated receipts and surpluses will be insufficient to
26 provide for appropriations.

27 * Sec. 4. AS 37.07.120 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

28 (4) "appropriation" means a maximum amount available for
29 expenditure by a state agency for a stated purpose set out in an appro-

1 priation Act;

2 (5) "allocation" means an amount set out as a legisla-
3 tive guideline for expenditure by a state agency for a stated purpose
4 within the total amount of an appropriation;

5 (6) "object of expenditure" means a line item of expenditure
6 within an allocation or an appropriation.

7 * Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 of this Act, trans-
8 fers between appropriations may be made as provided by law between appro-
9 priation items contained in Section 16(a) and (b) of Chapter 209, SLA 1975.

10 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1976.
