6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Boards of Fisheries and Game;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.221 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.221. BOARDS OF FISHERIES AND GAME. (a) For purposes
11 of the conservation and development of the fishery resources of the
12 state, there is created the Board of Fisheries composed of seven members
13 appointed by the governor. The appointed members shall be residents of
14 the state and shall be appointed without regard to political affiliation
15 from the following general geographical areas of the state: South-
16 eastern Alaska including Yakutat, Prince William Sound, Cook Inlet,
17 Kodiak, Alaska Penninsula and Aleutian Islands, Bristol Bay, and the
18 Arctic, Yukon and Kuskokwim [OR GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF RESIDENCE].
19 The commissioner is not a member of the Board of Fisheries, but shall be
20 ex officio secretary.

21 (b) For purposes of the conservation and development of the game
22 resources of the state, there is created the [A] Board of Game composed
23 of seven members appointed by the governor. The appointed members shall
24 be residents of the state, and shall be appointed without regard to
25 political affiliation from the following general geographical areas of
26 the state: Arctic, Northwestern Alaska, Yukon, Southwestern Alaska,
27 Southcentral Alaska, and Southeastern Alaska [OR GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION
28 OF RESIDENCE]. The commissioner is not a member of the Board of Game,
29 but shall be ex officio secretary.
