6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Fisheries; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.221(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) For purposes of the conservation and development of the
11 fishery resources of the state, there is created the Board of Fisheries
12 composed of seven members appointed by the governor. The appointed
13 members shall be residents of the state and shall be appointed without
14 regard to political affiliation from the following general geographical
15 areas of the state: Southeastern Alaska including Yakutat, Prince
16 William Sound, Cook Inlet, Kodiak, Alaska Penninsula-Aleutian Islands,
17 Bristol Bay, and the Arctic-Yukon and Kuskokwim [OR GEOGRAPHICAL LOCA-
18 TION OF RESIDENCE]. The commissioner is not a member of the Board of
19 Fisheries, but shall be ex officio secretary.

20 * Sec. 2. Members serving on the Board of Fisheries on the effective date
21 of this Act shall continue to serve until their term expires. Upon the
22 expiration of a member's term a new member shall be appointed from a geo-
23 graphical area specified in sec. 1 of this Act so that equal geographical
24 representation is implemented in a continuing manner, and in no case may
25 unequal representation exist after July 1, 1978.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect June 30, 1976.
