6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judicial pay and retirement; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.15.220(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) Each magistrate shall receive annual compensation to be
11 determined by the supreme court. Salary increases shall be determined
12 on the basis of percentage of pay increase the legislature provides for
13 state employees in the classified service. The base salary of a magis-
14 trate shall be increased by a percentage equal to three and one-half per
15 cent times the number of step increases provided under AS 39.27.020 that
16 a state employee would receive working in the same election district.

17 A magistrate's annual compensation may be payable, at the option of the
18 magistrate, either monthly in 12 equal installments or semi-monthly in
19 24 equal installments.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 22.25.010(f) is amended to read:

21 (f) In the computation of service for retirement under secs. 10 -
22 70 of this chapter, the time served by a justice or judge of any court
23 is added to the time served by him, if any, on any other court. All
24 service rendered by a justice or judge, including service as a magis-
25 trate or deputy magistrate, before July 1, 1967 [THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
26 SECS. 10 - 70 OF THIS CHAPTER] shall be included in the computation.

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 16, 1976.
